Your client loves all the natural light, but he finds the expansive windows can make glare overwhelming in the morning and evening. Because the kitchen has so many windows and he'll be adjusting the treatments so frequently, he wants something that will be very simple to use. Privacy isn't a concern in this part of the house.
